Good afternoon,

It has come to our attention that there is some misinformation being spread throughout the community. This misinformation gives our students and staff unneeded anxiety.

To that end, there has never been a discussion in administration regarding the elimination of AP courses due to low enrollment. In fact, the student registration window just recently closed. Myself, Dr. Greer, Dr. Janosko, and Mr. Nixon met on Tuesday morning, March 28th (yesterday) to discuss the enrollment in all of our high school level courses.

There will be two AP courses with enrollment that falls below 10 students. These two courses will need to go to the Board of Education for approval as per Board Policy 2312. However, I have spoken to the Curriculum Chair and she does not think continuing these vital courses will be an issue.
