- SaferWatch App - Mobile Panic Alarm demo
- Blake Ruderman provided a demonstration of the app and answered questions from Committee members.
  - The App is customizable and requires geofencing the buildings in the district.
  - "Tipster" feature to send tips.
    - Anonymous reporting is possible.
  - Can be set up for outbound notifications - Staff to Police.
  - Data collected includes - a phone number, first and last name, and an email address.
  - District owns the data. First Responders have access to the data and monitor the "back end" of the platform. There is a 365-day retention schedule.
  - GPS location allows for tracking when a button is hit. Photos and videos can also be sent if a user allows access to their cameras.
  - There is a "Resource Center" where electronic ID badges could be stored.
  - Over 3,500 schools are using the app, but none in New Jersey.
    - They are based in Florida.
  - They would be interested in doing promotional public relations with the district.
  - They heard about the district when Jarred Weisfeld contacted them.
