

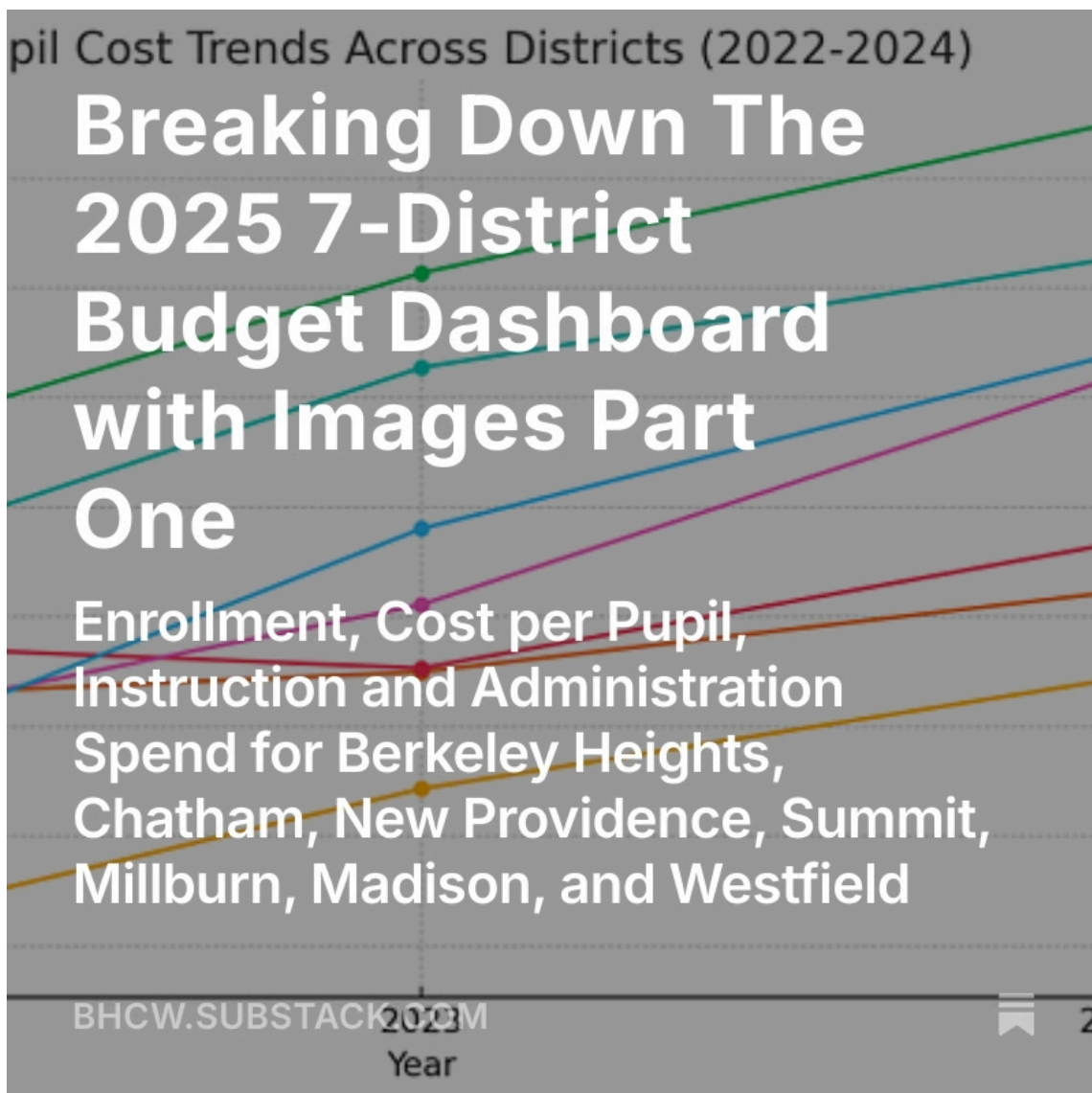

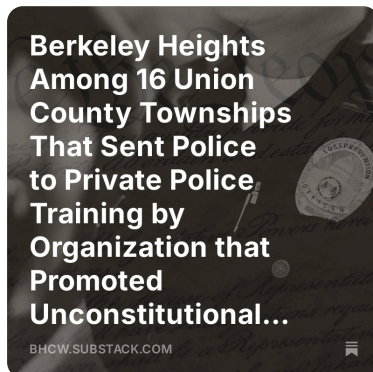


Notes from the Week
